This listing is in alphabetical order by business name. It takes the place of earlier editions published by the City and County of San Francisco, and by the Bay Area Pollution Prevention Group (BAPPG), the most recent of which was dated May 2011.

In order to be included here a distributor or manufacturer has provided current technical information about its amalgam separator equipment to the BAPPG. The submitted information includes a laboratory test of equipment effectiveness performed by an accredited laboratory according to the 1999 or later edition of Standard No. ISO-11143.

Dental practices contemplating the purchase of an amalgam separator are encouraged to contact the manufacturers to determine whether a specific unit on this list meets their needs (e.g., type of vacuum system, number of operatories, space requirements, etc.). Some of these units are available through local distributors in the San Francisco area. Dental practices should also refer to their local sewer agency for dates by which amalgam separators must be installed and for other program information.
