SWIMMING POOL/SPA WASTEWATER DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. NO addition of chemicals to pool/spa wastewater within several days of discharge, unless pH requires adjustment to meet requirements.
- 2. NO wastewater which has a pH of less than 6.0 or greater than 11.0 at the point of entry into the sanitary sewer is permitted (5.20.040 (B)(2)).
- 3. NO sand or diatomaceous earth from filter backwashing or any other maintenance procedures, or any other solid or viscous substances, is permitted to be discharged into the sanitary sewer (5.20.040 (B)(3)).
- 4. NO wastewater which has a temperature 150° Fahrenheit at the point of discharge into the sanitary sewer is permitted (5.20.040 (B)(5)).
- 5. NO unauthorized individuals shall open sewer manholes (5.20.040(C)). Drain pools and spas through the nearest available sewer cleanout.
- 6. NO use of copper containing algaecides (Pollution Prevention Program rule).
