NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 15, 2016, the Board of Directors of Dublin San Ramon Services District (DSRSD) will hold a public hearing to consider adopting an Urgency Ordinance pursuant to Water Code sections 350 through 357 and 71640 through 71644 (and the California Emergency Services Act) that will continue certain existing potable water use limitations, and modify or delete certain other mandatory restrictions and prohibitions for potable water use in response to the ongoing Community Drought Emergency.

Summary of Ordinance

The proposed Ordinance will repeal Ordinance No. 336 and prohibit certain types of potable water use, and it will allow other water uses subject to certain conditions and/or restrictions. The Ordinance will prohibit excessive potable water use, defined as unreasonable and inappropriate amounts of water based on thresholds that the Ordinance will define. The goal of these prohibitions and restrictions is and will be to meet statewide conservation requirements and to preserve the limited water supply for public health, safety, and fire protection. The Ordinance will be effective immediately upon adoption. Among the revisions to the existing potable water use limitations, restrictions, and prohibitions the Board may consider approving on March 15, 2016, are the following:

- Eliminating the requirement that pools and spas be covered at all times when not in use;
- Eliminating the requirement that pools and spas not be filled or re-filled with potable water.
