How can businesses use water wisely?

- Increase employee awareness and seek employee suggestions on wise water use
- · Repair dripping faucets and other plumbing such as running/leaking toilets
- Install water-efficient dishwashers, showerheads, pre-rinse spray valves, faucets, clothes washers, and flow reducers
- · Eating and drinking establishments: serve water only upon request
- · Hotels and motels: allow guests to choose to not have towels and linens laundered daily by displaying a written notice in each quest room.

Outdoors

- · Enlist your landscape maintenance company or property manager in conserving water
- Irrigate landscape early in the morning or late at night to reduce evaporation
- Avoid runoff by setting sprinklers to cover only the lawn/garden—not sidewalks or driveways. Or even better, choose drip irrigation
- · Adjust irrigation controllers for the seasons. Watering two to three times a week is usually plenty in summer
- Convert water-guzzling grass to water-efficient landscapes
- · Wash company vehicles less often and, when possible, use a car wash that recycles its wash water
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean pavement
