What is SB 998?



The Water Shutoff Protection Act



Codified as California Health and Safety Code Division 104,
Part 12, Chapter 6



Purpose: Provide significant protections for residential water customers with delinquent bills before disconnection of water service due to non-payment of charges



Requirements:

- 1. Adoption and posting of policy
- 2. New or expanded directives
- 3. Must be implemented immediately

SB 998 Requirements

Utility Service cannot be discontinued at 60 days of delinquency when customers meet specific medical and low-income requirements.

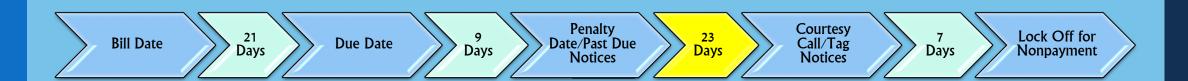
