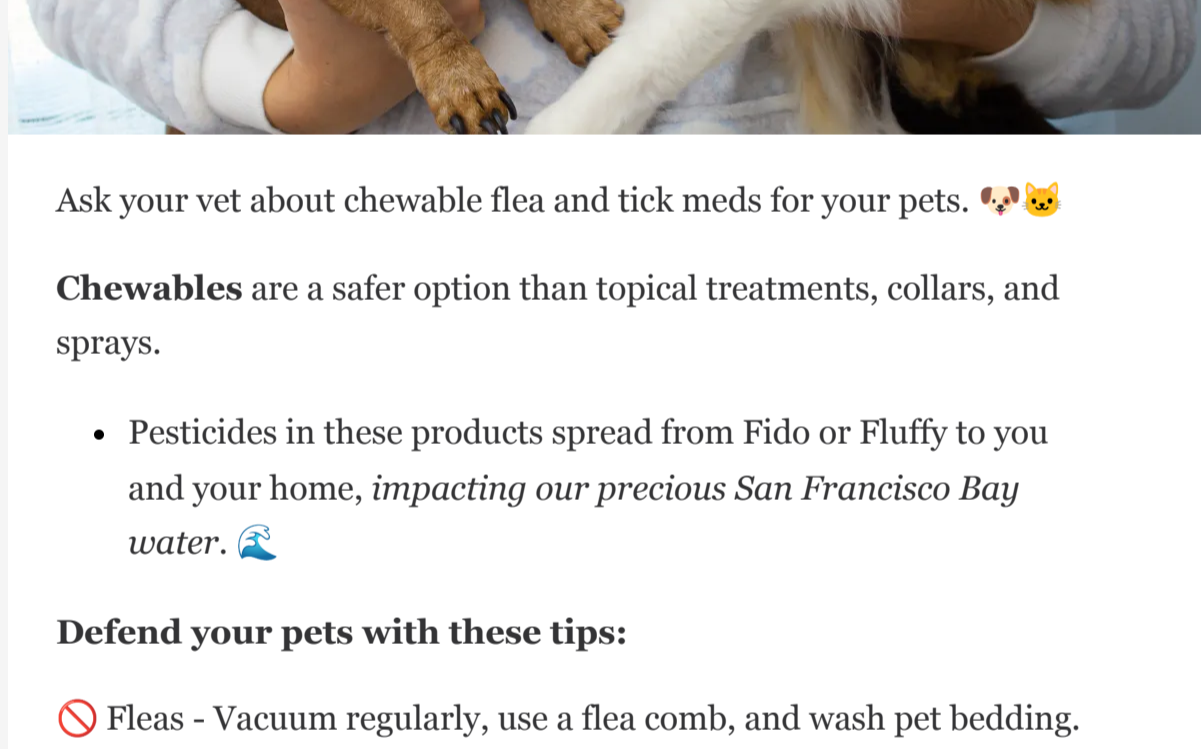

- Pesticides in these products spread from Fido or Fluffy to you and your home, *impacting our precious San Francisco Bay water.* 🌊

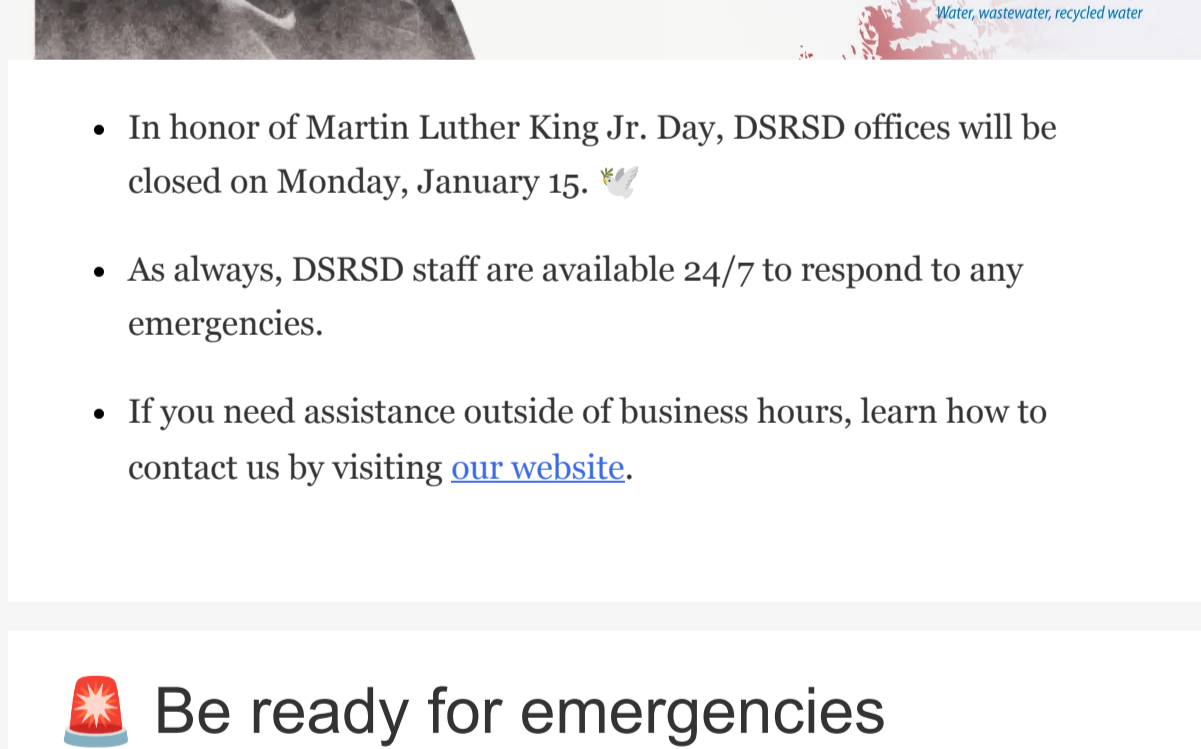
Defend your pets with these tips:

The bottom line: Let's keep our furry friends free from fleas and ticks - and protect the Bay while doing it. Share to spread the word!

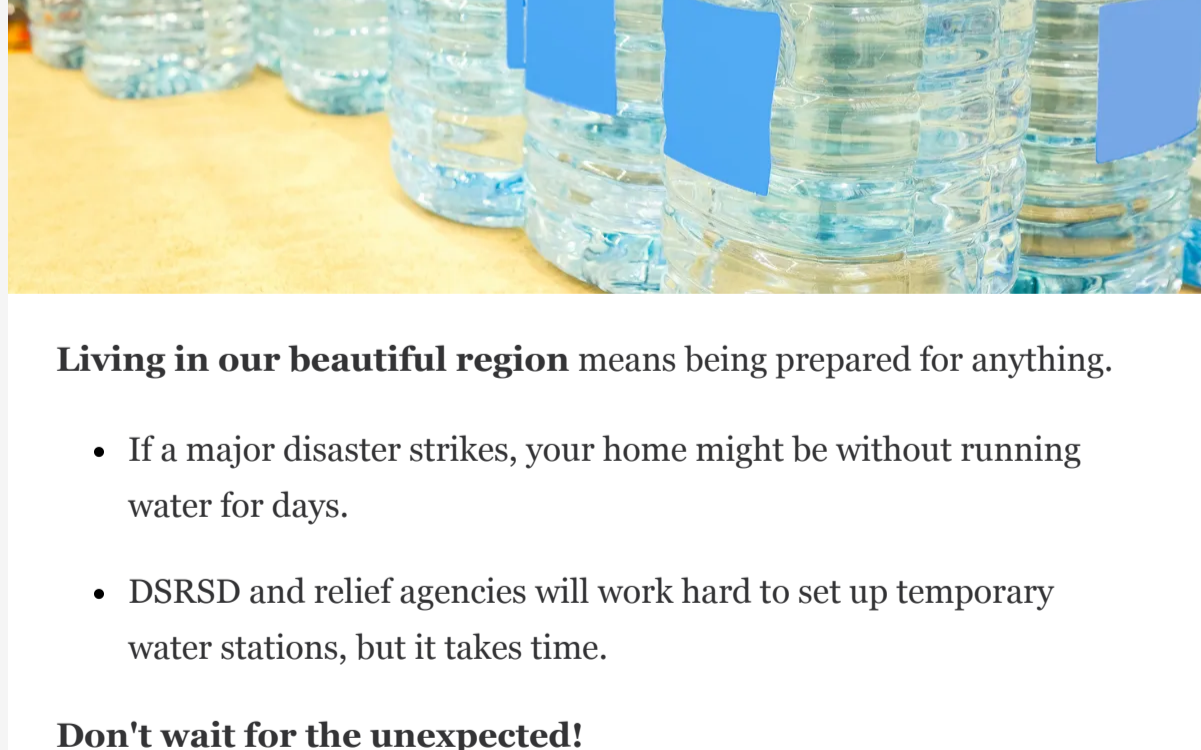

- While you can survive three weeks without food, you can't last more than three days without water.

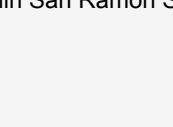
