





water. This method requires a little extra planning: a large frozen item like a turkey requires at least 24 hours for every 5 pounds, according to the <u>US Department of Agriculture</u>. Scrape leftovers from plates into the trash or green waste instead of rinsing food scraps and oils down the sink (it helps drains too!). Wash only full loads in the dishwasher.
