Conservation is a way of life for Californians.

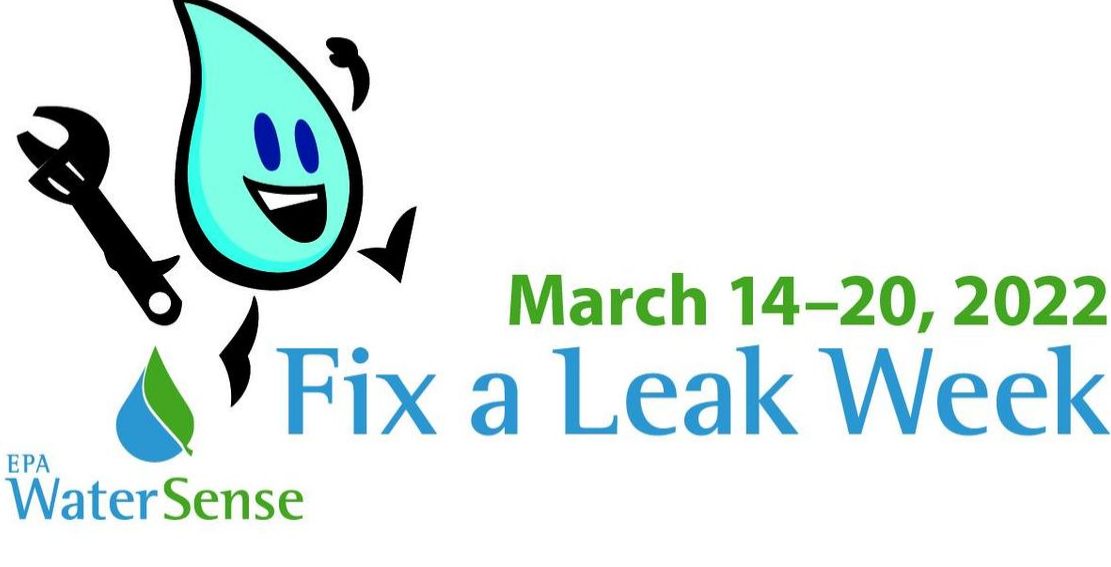
The first two months of 2022 show this continues to be a dry year. We are in a drought, and water conservation remains a necessary part of California life.

What they're saying: The State Water Resources Control Board adopted Drought Water Conservation Emergency Regulations currently in effect:

- Turn off decorative water fountains (fountains that recirculate water are exempted)
- Pause/turn off irrigation during rain and for two days after
- Use an automatic shut-off nozzle on water hoses
- Give trees what they need, but avoid overwatering
- Use a broom instead of water to clean driveways and sidewalks

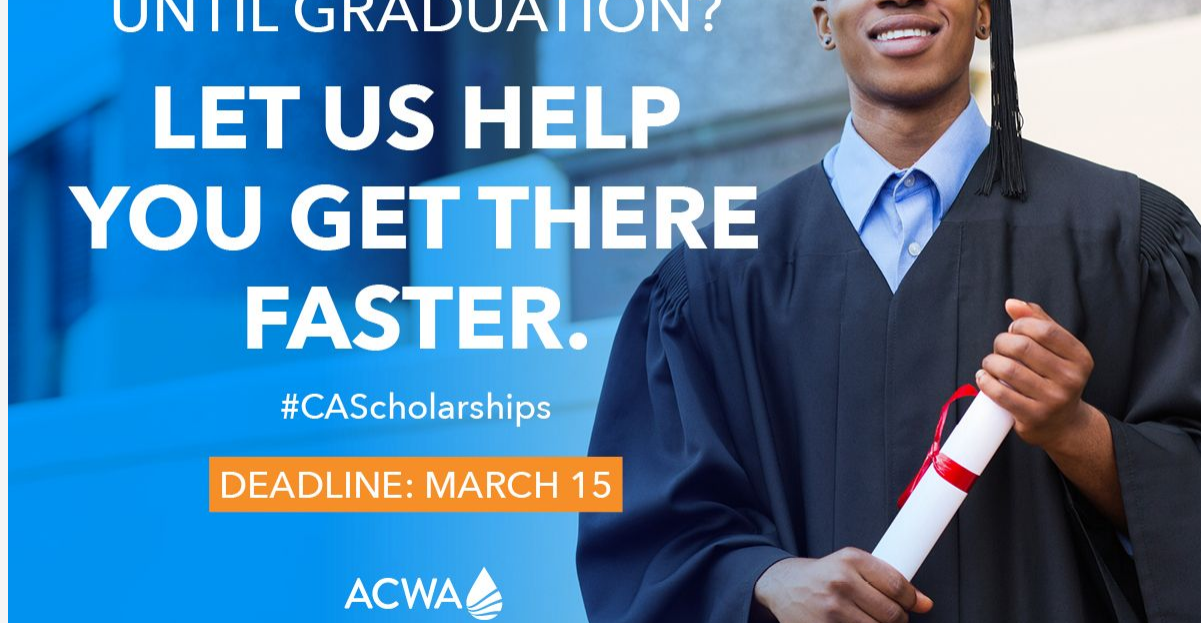
You don't always need the luck o' the Irish to find and fix leaks — and there's no time like now to save water at home.

Why it matters: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's annual [Fix a Leak Week](#) is March 14 to 20, 2022.

- Easy-to-fix water leaks account for nearly 1 trillion gallons of wasted water each year in homes nationwide.
- Because of leaks, the average household loses nearly 10,000 gallons of water each year — enough to wash 300 loads of laundry.
- These leaks can be a culprit for increasing water bills by 10%.

Flag Flying High at DSRSD Facilities

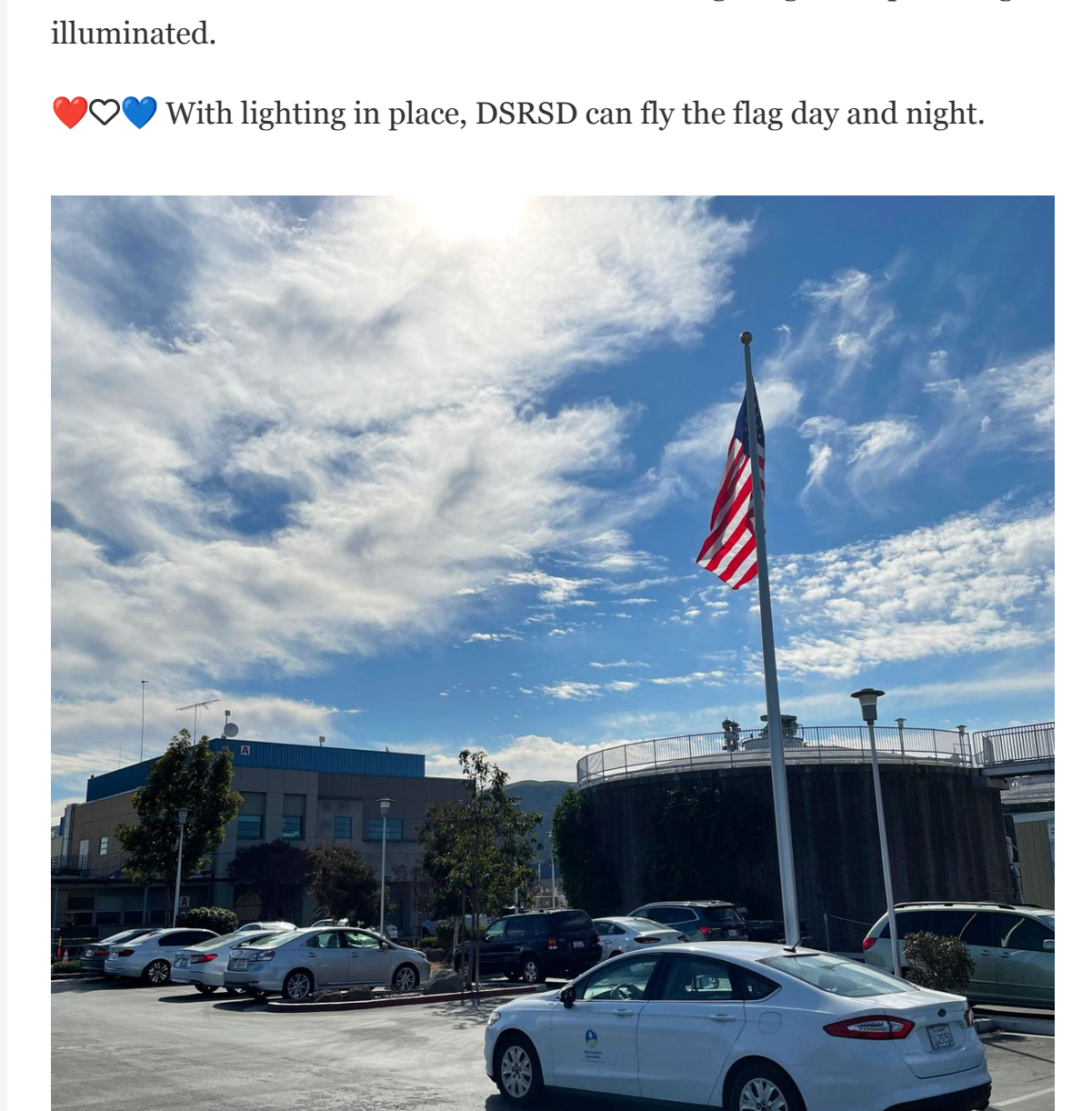


The new flagpole in front of DSRSD's Field Operations Facility.

❤️💙💜 With lighting in place, DSRSD can fly the flag day and night.



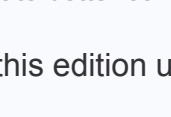
The new flagpole in front of the biosolids digesters at the Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility.
